

Planning Applications made to Milton Keynes Council for projects within the Great Linford Parish Council area in March 9 – 15, 2009

CHANGES TO THE APPEALS PROCESS - The Government is introducing a new system for dealing with most householder appeals which are made on or after, 6th April 2009. Householder (proposals for extensions to houses, garden fences, a garage in the garden etc) appeals that are being dealt with under the Written Representation process are going to be dealt with under a new streamlined process.

This process will mean only the information that was available to the Council when it dealt with the application will be considered by the Planning Inspectorate. There will be no opportunity for the Council, the applicant or any neighbours or Town/Parish Councils to make further comments to the Planning Inspectorate. If you are commenting on a householder application, please make sure you cover all the points that concern you at the application stage as you will not get another chance. These changes do not affect other types of applications or other forms of appeal.
