PLEASE CLEAR UP AFTER *YOUR* DOG!

Dog owners are responsible for picking up dog faeces, from the streets, parks and open spaces in Great Linford Parish.

DOG FOULING AND THE LAW

Milton Keynes Council designated the whole of the administrative area under the Dogs (Fouling of Land) Act 1996 as a poop and scoop area. Under the 1996 Act, if a dog owner does not clear up after a dog, they can be given a £50 fixed penalty notice and if they do not pay, taken to Court where they could pay a fine up to £1,000.

Milton Keynes Council recommend that dog owners pick up their dog's faeces in a plastic bag, take it home, then put it in another plastic bag and dispose of it in the black household refuse sack.

Do not wait until the law makes you pay up rather than clear up!

It is the policy of Great Linford Parish Council to provide free plastic bags and a very limited number of waste bins only in significant open spaces or parkland areas. Every bin cost up to £200 to install and around £155 a year to empty each week. A list of locations is available from the Parish Office. Or on the web site www.great-linford.gov.uk.

If there are no bins around, take the bag home and dispose of it in the black household refuse sack
